GETTING STARTED!

1. Decide

- Spiritual growth requires intentionality. Decide which reading guide you want to go through.
- Decide to make time with God a priority in 2024.

2. Plan

- This means setting a plan where you can give God your undivided attention.
- Plan the time, place and what you will be reading in your devotion.
- This increases the likelihood of following through with your devotion.
