

Begin running **quarterly seminars** by Nov 2021 on family and life-stage topics for both families and single-parent families, with **15** people attending each seminar.

35 (from 25) people to disciple another person by end of 2022

50 (from 35) people to be discipled by end of 2022

75% of all church leaders attend the first stage of "Leadership Development" by end of 2022

All ministry leaders to identify and raise up an assistant leader by end of 2022

Goals for 2021/2022

2 new cell plants every year by growing existing cell groups and raising up new cell leaders

Set up and implement a support structure for cell leaders by the end of 2022
