- 2. Sold as a slave for 20 shekels of silver (Genesis 37:28)
- 3. Falsely accused by Potiphar's wife (Genesis 39)
- 4. Joseph in prison (Genesis 40)

Living like a fugitive, running from place to place from Saul.

in developing your
character



#### Joseph's character development

- **Genesis 37:** Betrayed by his brothers, thrown into the pit. God tests Joseph's forgiveness.
- **Genesis 39:** Sexual temptation by Potiphar's wife. God tests Joseph's sexual and moral purity.
- **Genesis 40:** Baker and cup bearer asks their dreams to be interpreted. God tests whether Joseph still believes in dreams.

#### David's character development

- 1 Samuel 22:3-6. David runs to the stronghold of Moab. God tells him to go back into the wilderness, testing his true dependence.
- 1 Samuel 23:15. David hears about the Philistines plundering Keilah. David learns to seek God.
- 1 Samuel 24 & 26. Saul is delivered into David's hands. God tests if David will take matters into his own hands.
- 1 Samuel 30. Amalekites have taken David's and his men's women children and burned down Ziklag. David's men think of stoning him. David learns to strengthen himself in the LORD.

#### Genesis 41:46-49

Joseph was thirty years old when he entered the service of Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh and went through all the land of Egypt. During the seven plentiful years the earth produced abundantly, and he gathered up all the food of these seven years, which occurred in the land of Egypt, and put the food in the cities. He put in every city the food from the fields around it. And Joseph stored up grain in great abundance, like the sand of the sea, until he ceased to measure it, for it could not be measured.
