PRIORITIES OF THE PEOPLE OF GOD (OT)

Deuteronomy 7:6-9

6 For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. The Lord your God has chosen you out of all the peoples on the face of the earth to be <u>his people, his</u> <u>treasured possession.</u>



Deuteronomy 7:6-9

7 The Lord did not set his affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples. 8 But it was because the Lord loved you and kept the oath he swore to your ancestors that he brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you from the land of slavery, from the power of Pharaoh king of Egypt.



Deuteronomy 7:6-9

9 <u>Know therefore that the Lord your God is God;</u> he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments.

Acts 2:42-47

42 They <u>devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching</u> and to <u>fellowship</u>, to the breaking of bread and to <u>prayer</u>. 43 Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. 44 <u>All</u> <u>the believers were together and had everything in</u> <u>common</u>.



Acts 2:42-47

45 They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favour of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

The Bride

Ephesians 5:25-27

25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her 26 to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, 27 and <u>to present her to himself as</u> <u>a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other</u> <u>blemish, but holy and blameless.</u>



Hebrews 3:13-14

13 But <u>encourage one another daily</u>, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. 14 <u>We have come to share in</u> <u>Christ, if indeed we hold our original conviction firmly to the very end.</u>

1 Peter 5:5

5 you also, like <u>living stones</u>, are being <u>built into a</u> <u>spiritual house to be a holy priesthood</u>, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.



1 Peter 5:9-10

9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, <u>that you may</u> <u>declare the praises of him who called you out of</u> <u>darkness into his wonderful light.</u> 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.



The Building

the church declares the praises of God to the world and is used by God to build His kingdom The Body

1 Corinthians 12:12-14

12 Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but <u>all</u> <u>its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ</u>. 13 For we were all baptised by <u>one Spirit so as to form</u> <u>one body</u>—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. 14 Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many.



1 Corinthians 12:25-26

25 ...there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. 26 If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it.
