LET'S GO DEEPER!

1. Summarise: How would I put what I've read into my own words?

- Starting here helps us not just comprehend but crystallise and synthesize what we have read.
- Write in point form, prose, or whatever works best for you.

2. Key Observations: What stood out to me?

- Was there a repeated word, verse, phrase that spoke to me? Write it down and note why this spoke to you.
- There might also be 'ah-ha' moments and principles that we might glean from our reading.

3. What does this passage say about God?

- This is an important question as the Scriptures point to God and His Character.
- Too often we let our projections of what we think God is like define who He is, and this is why this question is important.

4. What does this passage say about me?

- Reading the Scriptures can be like a mirror. Allow God's word to pierce our souls and illuminate our hearts so that it leads to spiritual transformation.

5. Application: What can I do about what I have read?

- Let's not just be hearers of the Word, but doers of the Word. It is applying what God has said that ultimately changes our lives.
- Application can look like actions, a kind word, prayer, a mind-set shift etc.
