

### Psalm 119:137-144

<sup>129</sup>Your statutes are wonderful; therefore I obey them. <sup>130</sup>The unfolding of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple. <sup>131</sup>I open my mouth and pant, longing for your commands. <sup>132</sup>Turn to me and have mercy on me, as you always do to those who love your name. <sup>133</sup>Direct my footsteps according to your word; let no sin rule over me. <sup>134</sup>Redeem me from human oppression, that I may obey your precepts. <sup>135</sup>Make your face shine on your servant and teach me your decrees. <sup>136</sup>Streams of tears flow from my eyes, for your law is not obeyed.

<sup>145</sup>I call with all my heart; answer me, LORD, and I will obey your decrees. <sup>146</sup>I call out to you; save me and I will keep your statutes. <sup>147</sup>I rise before dawn and cry for help; I have put my hope in your word. <sup>148</sup>My eyes stay open through the watches of the night, that I may meditate on your promises. <sup>149</sup>Hear my voice in accordance with your love; preserve my life, LORD, according to your laws. <sup>150</sup>Those who devise wicked schemes are near, but they are far from your law. <sup>151</sup>Yet you are near, LORD, and all your commands are true. your love. <sup>152</sup>Long ago I learned from your statutes that you established them to last forever.

- <sup>153</sup>Look on my suffering and deliver me, for I have not forgotten your law. <sup>154</sup>Defend my cause and redeem me; preserve my life according to your promise. <sup>155</sup>Salvation is far from the wicked, for they do not seek out your decrees. <sup>156</sup>Your compassion, LORD, is great; preserve my life according to your laws. <sup>157</sup>Many are the foes who persecute me, but I have not turned from your statutes. <sup>158</sup>I look on the faithless with loathing, for they do not obey your word. <sup>159</sup>See how I love your precepts; preserve my life, LORD, in accordance with

<sup>161</sup>Rulers persecute me without cause, but my heart trembles at your word. <sup>162</sup>I rejoice in your promise like one who finds great spoil. <sup>163</sup>I hate and detest falsehood but I love your law. <sup>164</sup>Seven times a day I praise you for your righteous laws. <sup>165</sup>Great peace have those who love your law, and nothing can make them stumble. <sup>166</sup>I wait for your salvation, LORD, and I follow your commands. <sup>167</sup>I obey your statutes, for I love them greatly. <sup>168</sup>I obey your precepts and your statutes, for all my ways are known to you.

### Psalm 119:169-176

<sup>169</sup>May my cry come before you, LORD; give me understanding according to your word. <sup>170</sup>May my supplication come before you; deliver me according to your promise. <sup>171</sup>May my lips overflow with praise, for you teach me your decrees. <sup>172</sup>May my tongue sing of your word, for all your commands are righteous. <sup>173</sup>May your hand be ready to help me, for I have chosen your precepts. <sup>174</sup>I long for your salvation, LORD, and your law gives me delight. <sup>175</sup>Let me live that I may praise you, and may your laws sustain me. <sup>176</sup>I have strayed like a lost sheep. Seek your servant, for I have not forgotten your commands.

# **1. What does the psalmist say about** the Word of God?

wonderful (v. 129), gives light (v. 130), gives understanding to the simple (v. 130), right (v. 137), righteous (vv. 138, 144, 160, 164, 172), thoroughly tested (v. 140), true (vv. 142, 151, 160), give me delight (v. 143, 174), last forever (v. 152), eternal (v. 160), great spoil (v. 162), and sustain me (v. 175).

"All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in **righteousness**, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work."

2 Timothy 3:16-17

**Righteousness** refers to a state of being aligned with God's will and character.

*Truth is associated with God's faithfulness and the fulfillment of his promises.* 

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 14:6

But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. John 16:13

Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.

Ephesians 4:15

# 2. What does the psalmist do about the Word of God?

obey (vv. 129, 134, 145, 167, 168), keep (v. 146), long or pant (v. 131), not forgotten (vv. 141, 153, 176), hope (v. 147), meditate (v. 148), learn (v. 152), not turned from (v. 157), love (vv. 140, 159, 163, 167), heart trembles (v. 161), rejoice (v. 162), praise God (v. 164), follow (v. 166), sing (v. 172), chosen (v. 173)

All the paths of the Lord are steadfast love and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and his decrees.

Psalm 25:10

Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me.

John 14:21

God doesn't just want our obedience. Besides, you can do something right with the wrong motivations. God wants an obedience that flows from being in love with him, which are the right motivations.

# 3. What does the psalmist ask the Lord to do?

turn to me (v. 132), have mercy on me (v. 132), direct my footsteps (v. 133), let no sin rule over me (v. 133), redeem me (vv. 134, 154), make your face shine (v. 135), give me understanding (vv. 144, 169), answer me (v. 145), hear my voice (v. 149), preserve my life (vv. 149, 154, 156, 159), look on my suffering (v. 153), deliver me (vv. 153, 170), defend my cause (v. 154), teach me (v. 171), help me (v. 173), let me live (v. 175), seek me (v. 176)

The psalmist is not just seeking physical survival, but a fullness of life that is only possible through a deep relationship with God and a commitment to his ways.
