A feeling of resentful longing or bitterness triggered by someone else's possessions, qualities or luck...

jealousy + covetousness

jealousy

Occurs when something we already possess (usually a special relationship) is threatened by a third person.

“You shall not bow down to them or worship them for I, the LORD your God, am a **jealous God**.”

Exodus 20:5 (NIV)

covetousness

“You shall not **covet** your neighbour’s house. You shall not covet your neighbour’s wife, or his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbour.”

Exodus 20:17 (NIV)

covetousness

Yearning to possess something, especially something belonging to another person.

¹⁹ The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; ²⁰ idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions ²¹ and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.
