Life is the classroom for discipleship.


The everyday moments of your life is the curriculum that God the Holy Spirit uses to shape you to become more like Jesus.

Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

Galatians 5:19-21 (NLT)




The Holy Spirit helps you overcome by first changing the desires of your heart before other people and circumstances.

# TAKE ONE STEP OF TRUST AT A TIME

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. 24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.

Keeping in step with the Holy Spirit requires trust, not logic.

Resist the temptation to micromanage the Holy Spirit's work in you.
